Dear Parents/Carers,

I mentioned a few weeks ago that developing children's ability to become reflective learners was something we tried to encourage. I thought you might want to read a few of the reflections from some of our older learners.

I will also share some of our younger children's thoughts in the next few weeks.



*I think I have become more confident when I share answers and my opinions throughout Y6 because I like learning. Across the school, I have learnt that trying hard helps me when I'm stuck because then I can challenge myself. I think I have been a very different learner since Reception because I'm mature.*

*As a learner, I have changed a lot since I started school. I have definitely got a better mindset and I used to give up nearly straight away but now I persevere more and work through hard questions.*

*I have started to be more resilient with my work, and I'm pushing to be even more resilient in the future. I'd say that I have a growth mindset in my work, as I explained a second ago, I think as a Reception child, we are less mature and don't have so*

*many great attitudes to learning, but this changes as we get older. For example, as a Y1 we might give up, but we slowly start growing out of that habit as we grow up. When I was little, a mistake was like the end of the world, and that habit doesn't stop as easily as others, but mistakes can help.*

*I have grown more mature in my learning, and I especially like that now, in Year 6, we are beginning to reflect more on our work. I like looking back on our work and seeing how we can improve. Then also applying the mistakes we have made instead of just taking notes and then not using them.*

One of the main themes is perseverance and resilience, and it has been pleasing to see more of our learners realising that success will often come if they persevere and believe in themselves.
